
You have decided to work with us in Liběchov, here you can find some basic information about this town.

<u>Liběchov</u>

Liběchov is a small town in the Central Bohemian Region. It has about 1,100 inhabitants and it is located about 36 km north of Prague on the right bank of the Elbe River, approximately halfway between towns of Mělník and Štětí.

1) Transport to Liběchov

Well, now you know, where to find Liběchov on the map. But how do you get there?

A) BY PLANE

The Vaclav Havel Prague Airport is an important international crossroads regularly served by airlines from most EU and non-EU countries. Once you land in, take bus No 119 to get to the Prague centre and then connect to public transport, the best is the underground, Line C (the red line), which takes you to Ládví station. Then, take bus No 369, which will directly take you to Liběchov.

B) BY BUS

The best connection to Liběchov is from Prague, from Ládví station (underground, Line C) where you can take bus No 369, it takes about one hour. To see the bus timetable, please click on the following webpage: https://idos.idnes.cz/en/vlakyautobusymhdvse/spojeni/
